Essential Criteria

- At least one year experience of providing high quality advice at generalist level with a sound knowledge of generalist enquiry areas, in particular welfare benefits and debt

- 4. Proven ability to work out benefit calculations and better-off calculations in a system where Universal Credit and legacy benefits operate alongside,
- 5. Proven ability to research, analyse and interpret complex information, understanding statistics and checking the accuracy of calculations and produce and present clear reports verbally and in writing.
- 6. The capacity to work unsupervised or with minimal supervision
- 7. Good communication and IT skills to deal efficiently with queries, using online information and recording cases on our IT system
- 8. The ability to meet deadlines and manage your workload in a pressured environment
- 9. Proven understanding of equality and diversity and its application to the provision of advice.
- 10. Ability to commit and work within the aims, principles and policies of the Citizens Advice service.
